

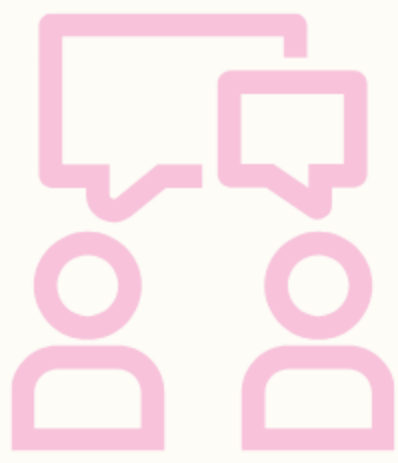
Workshops: Block #1
